

Education FAQ

1. How can I obtain the CA professional qualification curriculum?

- The curriculum is available for sale at the CA Sri Lanka Sales Centre.
- A copy of the CA curriculum is available in the library for reference.

2. Can I sit for paper based examination?

Students are allowed to sit for knowledge modules paper based upon the fulfillment of other relevant examination criteria. Students who do not follow fulltime studies are strongly advised to complete the qualification paper based for effective exam preparation & exam success.

3. What are the study materials available?

The following study Materials are available for the students;

- Study Texts
- Practice & Revision Kits

It is important that not only the student should fully understand the topics by reading carefully the information contained in the study text, but also vital that student should practice the techniques and apply the principles that has learned.

In order to do this, student should;

- Work through all the examples provided within the chapters and review the solutions in Study Text ensuring that student has understand them.
- Complete the progress test for each chapter in Study Text.

In addition, student should use the Practice & Revision kit. These questions will provide student with excellent examination practice when students are in the revision phase of their studies.

4. How can I purchase the study texts?

- You are required to use a CA Sri Lanka Bank Deposit slip which has three copies;
1. Bank copy 2. CA Sri Lanka Copy 3. Student copy
- Make the relevant payment to any Bank of Ceylon branch remitting the payment to CA Sri Lanka account. (Use the relevant bank payment codes for each study texts which are mentioned on the reverse side of the payment slip.)

- Submit the CA Sri Lanka copy to the study text sales counter to collect the study texts.
- You can also collect your study packs from CA Sri Lanka Information Centers located across the country.
- Access to practice & Revision kits will be granted free of charge after purchasing the study texts.

5. What are the prices of study texts?

6. What is the deadline to collect study texts?

Students who apply for any subject as a first attempter should pay and collect the study text at least one week prior to the closing date of submitting the examination application.

Students should not;

- Wait till the examination deadline to collect the study texts
- Wait to collect the study text after releasing examination results
- Attach study pack payment slip with the exam application
- Enter wrong payment codes/payment values in cash deposit slip
- It is strongly recommend to collect the study materials at the beginning of the course and plan your study & exam questions practice through the program.

7. Should I purchase study pack again after the curriculum change?

In curriculum changes it is not compulsory to purchase the study texts as an exam eligibility criteria, if you have purchased that under the old curriculum.
